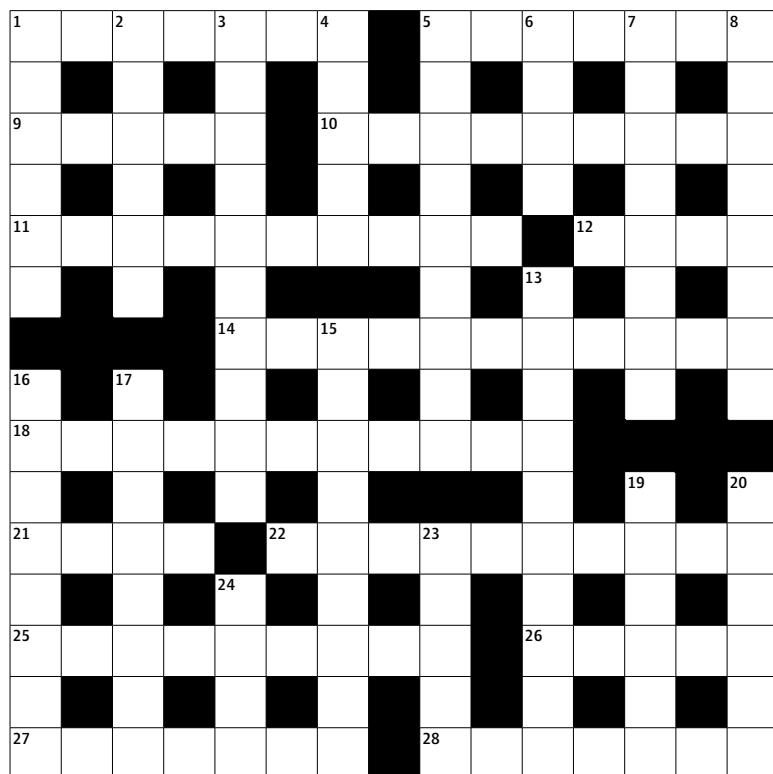


Guardian cryptic crossword No 28,573 set by Vulcan
