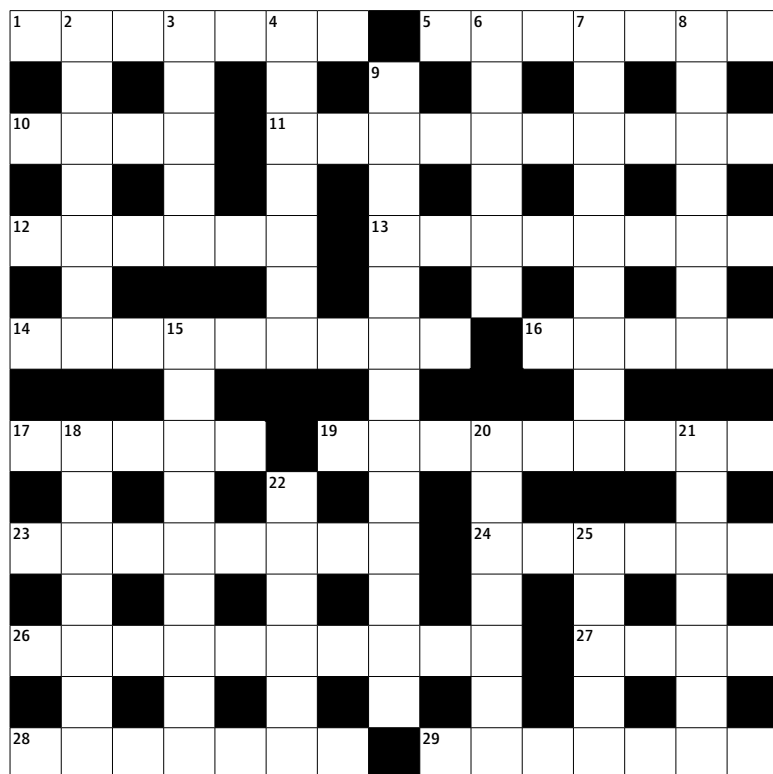


Guardian cryptic crossword No 29,994 set by Tramp
