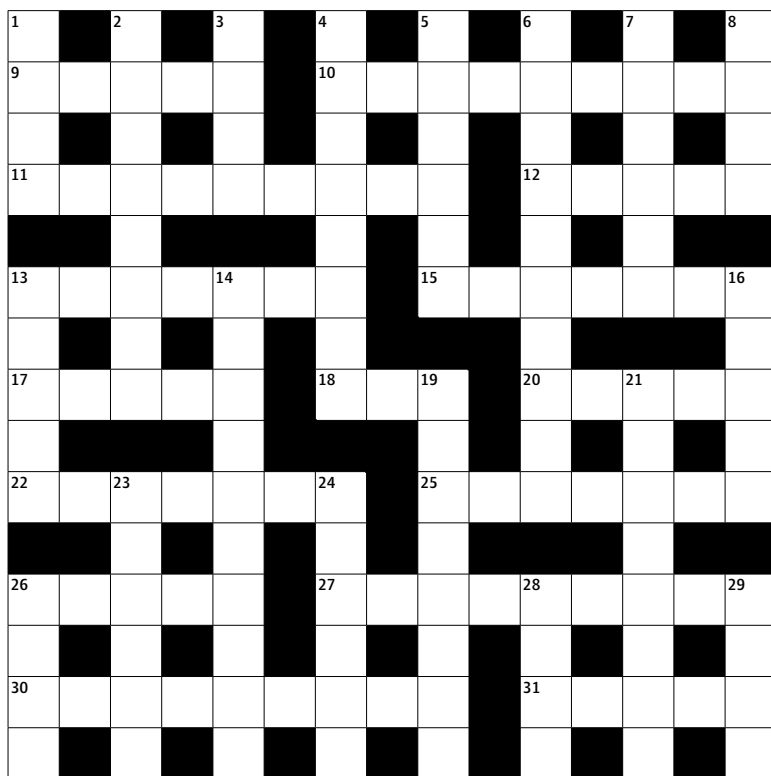


Guardian cryptic crossword No 30,041 set by Brummie
