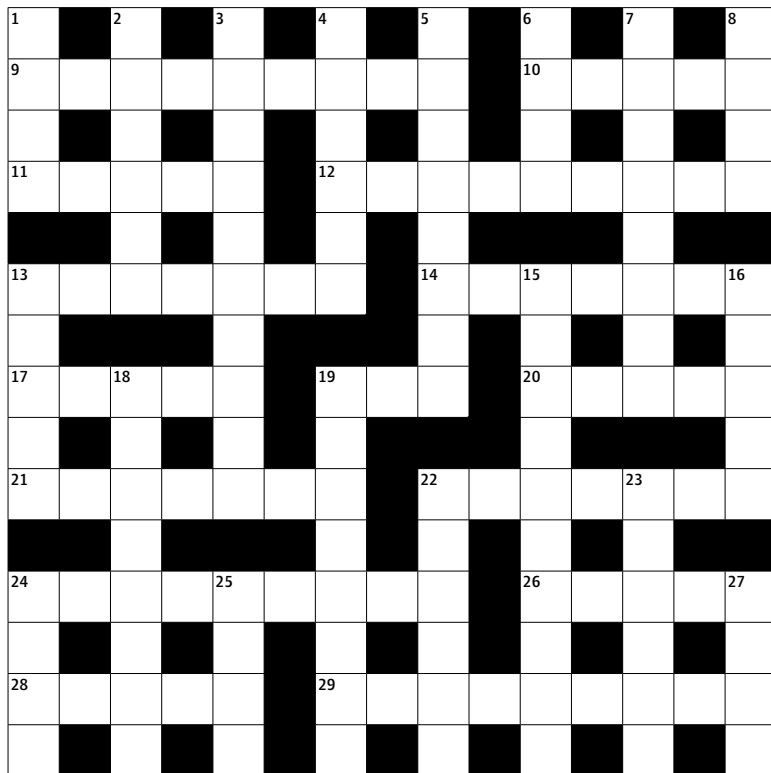


Guardian cryptic crossword No 30,048 set by Paul
