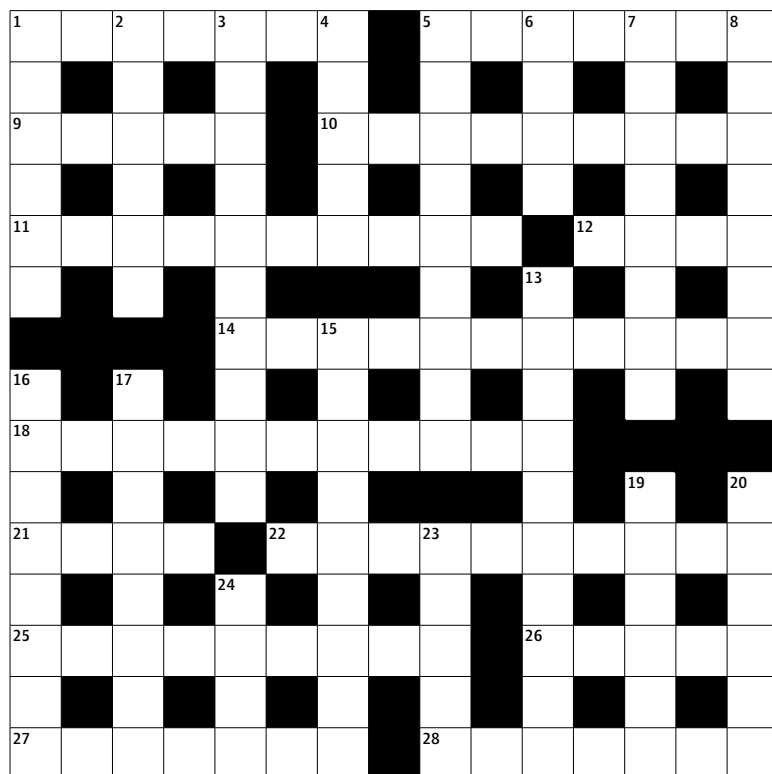


Guardian cryptic crossword No 30,065 set by Fed
