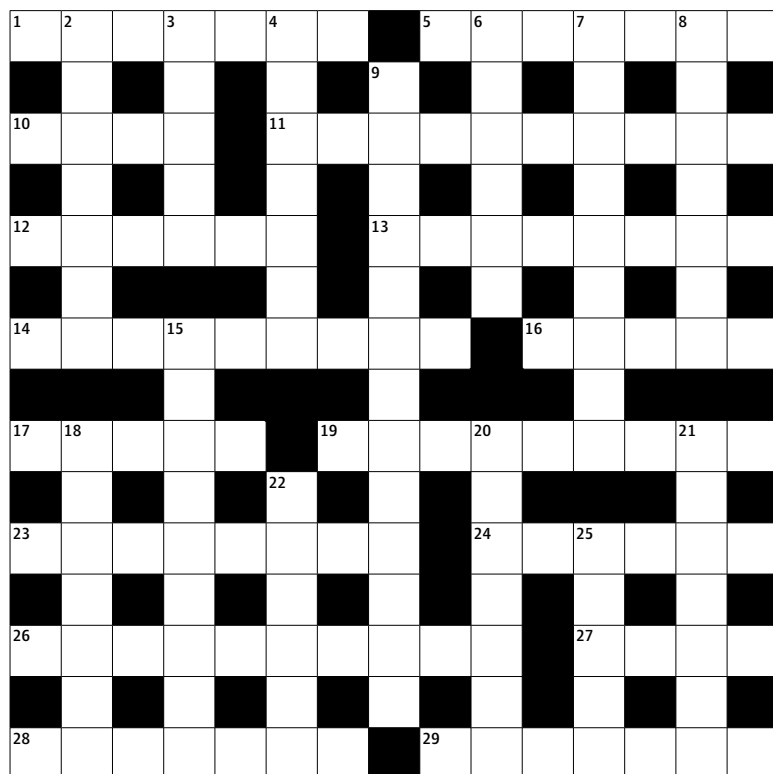


Guardian cryptic crossword No 30,067 set by Imogen
