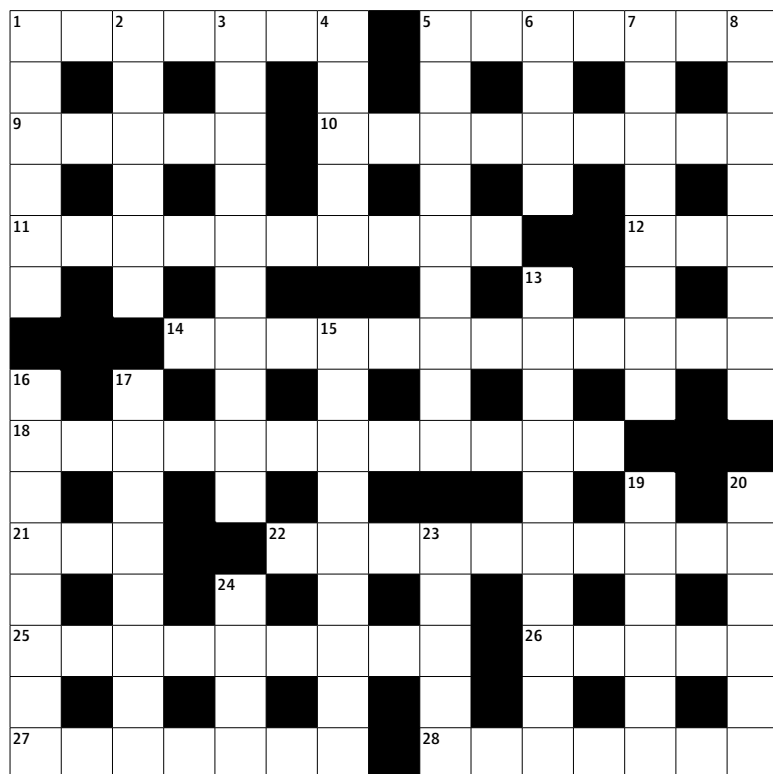


Guardian cryptic crossword No 30,079 set by Fed
