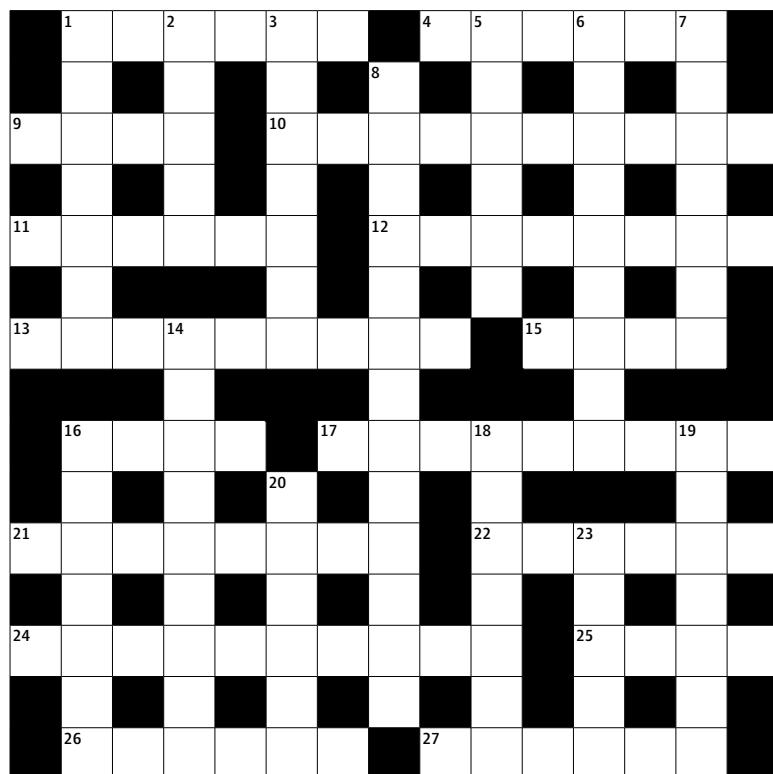


Guardian cryptic crossword No 30,088 set by Maskarade
