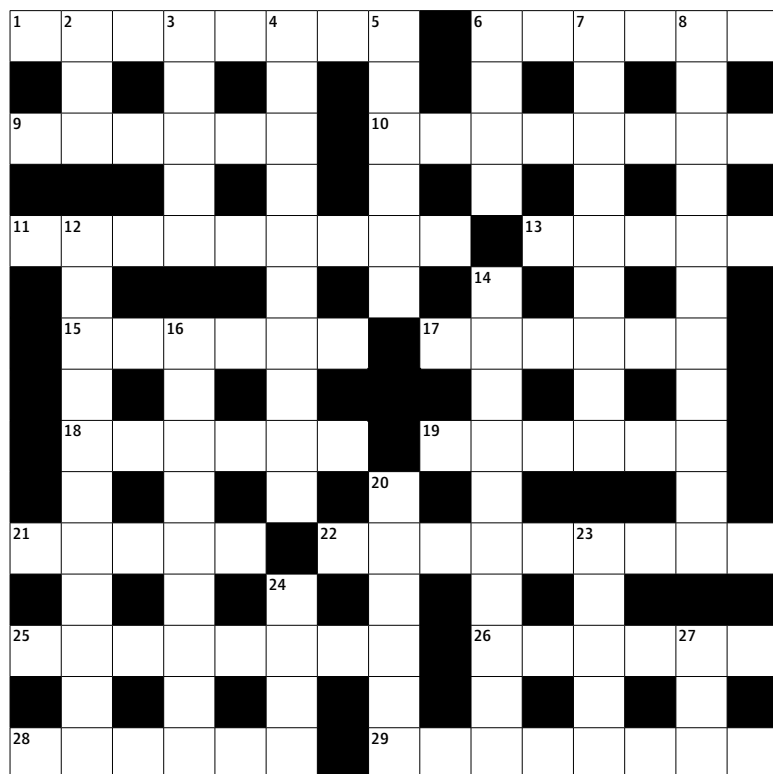


Guardian cryptic crossword No 30,094 set by Turnstone
