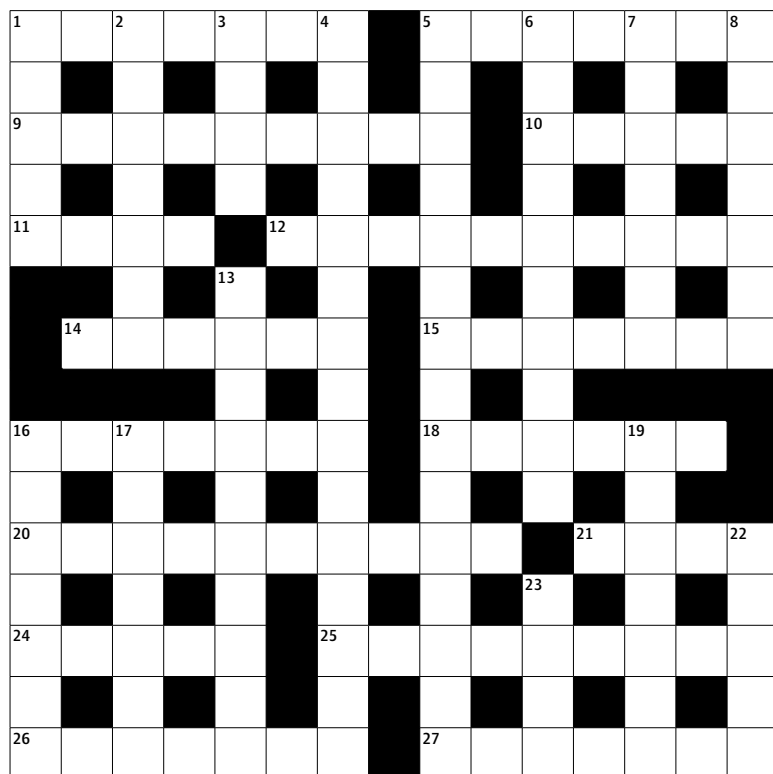


Guardian cryptic crossword No 30,096 set by Tramp
