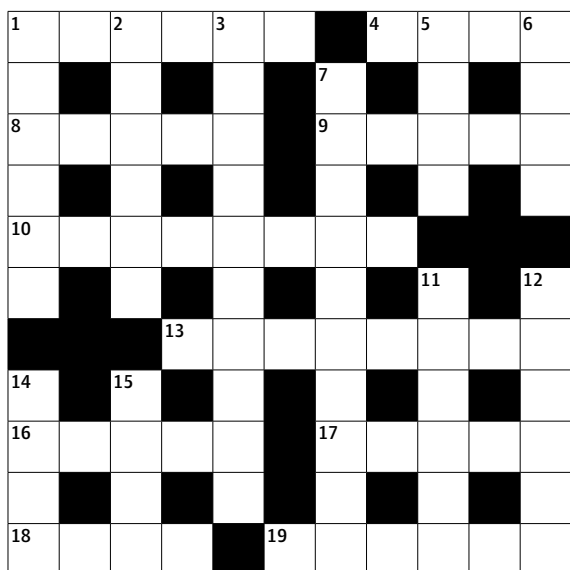


# Guardian quick cryptic crossword
