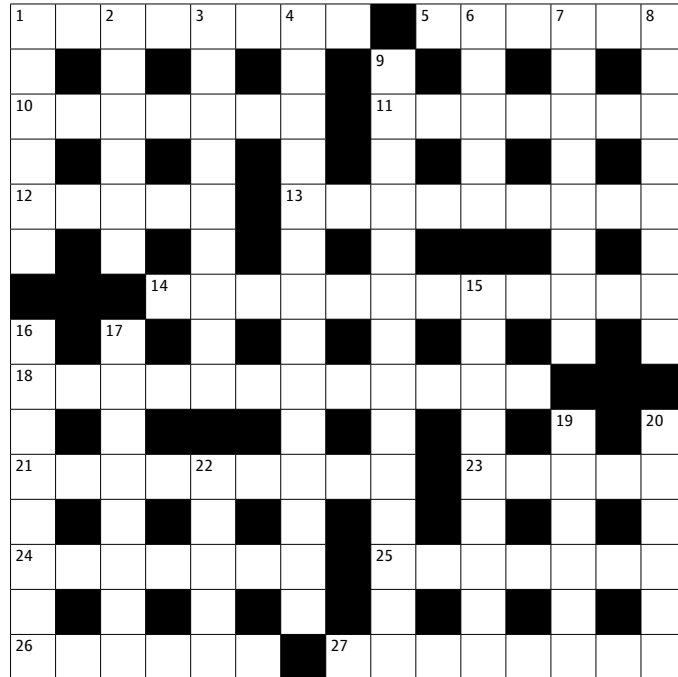


# Everyman crossword No.3880
